

Subject: Supplemental information to PCN202111001, issued on November 30, 2021

To: Whom it may concern

On November 31, 2021, we sent the attached PCN to inform you of a change of part number to identify products without electric isolation between the 0-10V dimming lines and the LED output lines.

We asked you to change all your backlog and place all new orders to the new part numbers with the “-FN” suffix such that the part numbers with the “-FN” suffix would pertain to products without electric isolation between the 0-10V Dimming lines and the LED output lines.

FYI, the electrical isolation between the 0-10V dimming lines and the LED output lines was achieved by an integrated circuit from Infineon. Infineon went into full allocation in Q4 2021 and told us they would stop deliveries of this integrated circuit in all of 2022.

However, we just received an unexpected shipment of the Infineon integrated circuit that is just enough to cover the backlog we have on the VZM series. As a result, your open order will be shipped using the previous part number, i.e. without the “-FN” suffix. So, please update the part numbers for PO# 3690455 in your system so that our invoices will match your purchase order.

- if we get deliveries from Infineon, we will ship VZM products without the FN suffix.
- If we do not get deliveries from Infineon, we will ship VZM products with the -FN suffix.
